

Riverside Golf Club will, from Thursday, June 3 at 11:59 pm move to follow the Victorian Government restrictions.

Riverside Golf Club will have the following conditions:

- There is a 50-person at one time limit on the golf course. This limit is inclusive of all people at the facility excluding staff;
- Time sheets will be open to **Riverside Golf Club Members Only** with timeslots being 20-minute increments.

Visitors can contact the golf club after 8am on the day they are wanting to play to check availability.

Saturday 5th June timesheet will open at 8am on Friday 4th June for Members.

- At the completion of your round, it would be appreciated if you can vacate the Riverside Golf Course as soon as practically possible.
- All members **must** book a time on the time sheet to access the course. This includes practice facilities.
- Riverside Golf Club will check the residential address of everyone on site to ensure they live in regional Victoria. Those who live in Melbourne will be refused service;
- Competitions cannot be conducted, however there will be handicapping of social scores and door prizes;
- Masks must continue to be worn inside, unless eating or drinking, or another lawful exception applies;
- Changerooms, locker rooms and showers must remain closed. Access to toilets is permitted;
- **All people using the course MUST USE the Service Victoria QR requirements or sign in.**

Refusal to do this will result in you being asked to leave the Riverside Golf Club.

Additionally:

- There is no limit on distance travelled from home within Regional Victoria;
- Food and beverage operations will be take-away only – adhering to a density requirement of one person per four square metres

Riverside Golf Club will adhere to the COVID-19 temporary local rules which includes:

- Flagsticks are to remain in the hole and not handled or removed
- Bunker rakes will be removed and a 'preferred lie within a card length' allowed
